Dear Contractor,

The San Fernando Valley Chapter of CLCA invites you to participate in our 59th Annual Landscape Beautification Awards Program. **Now is the time to prepare your projects for entry** into any one of the many categories including installation, renovation, and maintenance, as well as expanded water features and night lighting. We invite all members of our chapter as well as the Channel Islands and LA/SGV Chapters.

Projects will be judged by landscaping experts and they'll be looking at the skill and quality that goes into the projects entered.

Awards will be presented at a gala banquet at the Airtel Plaza Hotel in Van Nuys on **Saturday** evening, **June 16, 2018**. A networking reception and a delicious dinner will culminate with an exciting multi-media presentation of all entries, and of course, the presentation of the landscape beautification awards. Your invitation to the banquet will be mailed to you in early June.

This year we are once again excited to offer our own stimulus package. For all contractors who enter two projects, they will get a third entry free! If you pay to enter four, and you'll get two free. See the entry form for complete details. The basic entry fee is \$75.00 per entry if your entry is received on or before April 20, 2018. The fee for entries received after this date is \$130.00. No entries will be accepted after April 27, 2018. To qualify for the multi-entry discount, your entries must be in by the April 20th deadline. Late entries do not qualify for discounts. No entries will be accepted after Friday, April 27th. All entries must be accompanied by a check and emailed entries are not acceptable.

Judging will take place on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, May 3,4, 5, and 6th if needed. Please be sure that you do not have signage or vehicles with your name or logo on site during those days. To be fair, judging must be completely anonymous. And please advise your clients not to discuss the project with the judges in an attempt to influence their decisions.

To enter, please use the enclosed forms. **Note that there is one set of entry forms enclosed.** Make copies of these forms for multiple entries. Follow directions completely and review the enclosed categories page to determine the appropriate category. Incomplete forms may cause the project to be disqualified. If an entry is entered in the incorrect category, the judges reserve the right to move it to the correct or more appropriate category.

Special Effects Award

Best use of unique methods or materials and/or special artistic effects.

Colorscape Award

Best use of color in overall landscape.

Hardscape Award

Creative or best use of construction materials (concrete, wood, masonry, etc.)

Bob Moore Memorial Award

Best use of rockscape in the landscape.

Excelsior Award

For first year member exhibiting excellence in craftsmanship (joined after 1/1/17)

President's Choice Award

Residential project that best exhibits excellence in craftsmanship.

F.H. Arklin Memorial Award

Commercial project that best exhibits excellence in craftsmanship.

Stuart Sperber Memorial Sweepstakes Award

Judged best overall from all categories.

Regular Award Categories

Installation

- Small Residential A Single family residence with landscaping cost not to exceed \$15,000
- 2 **Small Residential B** Single family residence with landscaping cost from \$15,001 \$25,000
- 3 Medium Residential Single family residence with landscaping cost from \$25,001 - \$50,000
- 4 **Large Residential** Single family residence with landscaping cost from \$50,001- \$100,000
- 5 **Custom Residential** Single family residence with landscaping cost from \$100,001- \$250,000
- 6 Residential Estates Single family residence with landscaping cost above \$250,001
- 7 Design Build Any project designed and installed by contractor. Project must fall within scope of C-27 license. A plan must be submitted and will be judged.

Maintenance

19 Small Commercial

Maintenance Landscape maintenance on commercial property started prior to January 1, 2017 with monthly landscape maintenance cost of \$750 or less.

20 Medium Commercial

Maintenance Landscape maintenance on commercial property started prior to January 1, 2017 with monthly landscape maintenance cost of \$751 to \$4,000.

- 8 Renovation Any landscape renovation not more than 70% demolished. "Before" photos required.
- 9 Model Homes A series of three or more family units included in one subdivision
- 10 **Commercial Living Facilities**Any building or facility used on a

rental, lease or transient basis.
Includes hotels, motels, apartments
and condominium complexes.

11 Small Commercial/Industrial

Any type of building or structure used for business or manufacturing with landscaping costs not to exceed \$100,000.

12 Large Commercial/Industrial

Any type of building or structure used for business or manufacturing with landscaping costs from \$100,001+

- 13 **Public Works** Any public building or area financed by public funds.
- 21 Large Commercial

Maintenance Landscape maintenance on commercial property started prior to January 1, 2017 with monthly cost in excess of \$4,000.

22 Small Residential Maintenance

Landscape maintenance on single family residential property started prior to January 1, 2017 with monthly cost up to \$500.

23 Large Residential Maintenance

Landscape maintenance on single family residential property started prior to January 1, 2017 with monthly cost in excess of \$500.

- 14 **Xeriscape** Water conservation through creative landscaping (commercial or residential)
- 15 **Water Feature A** Waterfalls, ponds, fountains or streams (commercial or residential) with project cost up to \$15,000.
- 16 Water Feature B Waterfalls, ponds, fountains or streams (commercial or residential) with project cost over \$15,000.
- 17 **Night Lighting A** Any landscape lighting (commercial or residential) using **up to 50 fixtures.** Must submit lighting photos on thumb drive with entry.
- 18 **Night Lighting B** Any landscape lighting (commercial or residential) using **51 or more fixtures.** Must submit lighting photos on thumb drive with entry
- 24 **Public Works Maintenance** Any public building or area financed by public funds started prior to January 1, 2017.

25 Small HOA Maintenance

Landscape maintenance for HOA started prior to January 1, 2017 with monthly cost up to \$3,000.

26 Large HOA Maintenance

Landscape maintenance for HOA started prior to January 1, 2017 with monthly cost over \$3,000
